

Sharks can be viewed from the top side as well. Guests will be treated to a light lunch buffet of sandwiches with different variety of fillings, crisps, fruit basket, soft drinks, mineral water and juice. After heading back the group regroup at the lodge where they receive hot vegetable soup and rolls while the shark team show them their trip on the monitor. **Dress code:** swim wear under your warm clothes as wetsuits will be provided, dry clothes for afterwards and remember to take sea sickness tablets

Information: A tandem jump requires general good health. Age, history of major illness, injuries or operations may exclude participation. Children 10 years and older. Weight limit 100kg

Description: On the way up in the aircraft, the view is breathtaking. To the South, the Mother City lies sandwiched between towering Table Mountain and bustling Table Bay harbour. Further to the south, and to the far side of the mountain, lies False Bay, Hout Bay and the splendour of the South Peninsula as far as Cape Point. To the West, you will spot Robben Island - Cape Town's own Alcatraz - and the Atlantic breaking on the beautiful Cape West Coast, as famous for its icy water temperature as its mouth-watering crayfish. To the North, the Langebaan lagoon , a great kitesurfing and windsurfing venue. Less than an hour after landing from your Skydive, you could be gazing out at Robben Island from the top of Table Mountain, relaxing on a wine farm in Stellenbosch, or eating seafood in one of the many fine restaurants at the V&A Waterfront.

We stop at the Huegenot Chocolate Factory for a tour and tasting before turning back to La Bri, this time through the vineyards of Mont Rochelle for the trip's wine tasting. A fitting nod to the wine culture of Franschhoek! NOTE: the tour can be extended to include two wine tastings and one cellar tour, culminating in a Half-Day Trip.

A Minute 2 Win It! is a fast-paced event that will have your teams laughing, cheering and vying to become the Minute 2 Win It! Champion. This ultra-competitive event is a perfect addition to corporate events or as a stand-alone team building activity.

Clay Sculpting – From R275 per person

Each team member will get the same amount of clay. According to the assignment, you have to use your clay to sculpt something fantastic. Getting your hands dirty is the best way to get the creative juices flowing. Your creation could look great on your desk at work





CANVAS PAINTING – From R450 per person

4 day Orange river trips

The Orange River Gorge is the most spectacular and easy runnable white water section of the Orange River at the times of the year we operate.

Deep in the Kalahari, the river cuts through a moonscape of granite cliffs with the amazing Gariep Falls tumbling into the Orange River Gorge.

We run downriver over several days. Our Camp sites along the river are as unique as the experience.

The Highlight of the Orange River rafting trip will be the portage into the gorge itself – Once at the bottom of the Gorge we paddle a few meters up to where we see the Waterfall dropping into the Gorge itself.

Here we will abseil or lower everything in to the Gorge +/- 40 meters down to the River below the Waterfall.

The Orange River Gorge is a very remote destination and only accessible by foot or rafting – it is one of the most undisturbed sights you will ever witness. This experience will be one of the highlights of our expedition if not your life.

We will also spend some considerable time "monster fishing" and if you don't know how to fish one of our experienced guides will assist you.

At night around a small contained fire we will look up at the stars and experience a sight unlike you have ever witnessed.

Our December School holiday trip has unfortunately been fully booked.

If your interested let us know and we will forward you the Information you need – Our Orange river rafting expedition experience will ensure you have memories for a life time.
